



TERMS OF SERVICE

The primary purpose of Furry Connection North (henceforth known as FCN) is to provide a fun and safe environment for its members. In order to ensure that the event maintains a pleasant atmosphere for everyone, we must require for all attendees to follow an accepted code of conduct. By encouraging all who take part in the event to behave in a way that is acceptable and inoffensive to the majority of the attendees, we can help to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable time at Furry Connection North.

Furry Connection North welcomes those with an interest in anthropomorphics, however the staff reserves the right to deny or revoke the membership of any individual at any time for any reason. The removal of an attendee's membership status and convention privileges will most likely be enacted if that attendee's actions or behavior is found to be disruptive to the safety or enjoyment of other attendees, inhibits or interferes with convention operations or with the staff of the hotel or of Furry Connection North.

Upon accepting membership to any Furry Connection North event, the member agrees to hold harmless Furry Connection North and its staff from any legal action resulting from

personal injury or property damage or loss due to the actions of any individual within the event or otherwise, including members of the Furry Connection North staff.

Furry Connection North holds the right to alter this code of conduct at any time with or without notice.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership to FCN events may be purchased online (www.furryconnect.com) or at the registration desk upon arrival at the site. To gain membership, government issued identification must be shown and a formal agreement to adhere to the standards of conduct must be signed. Every member will receive a membership badge. This badge must be kept with the member and be openly visible at all times while within the convention area. Any member who is not able to display their membership badge if requested by staff may be denied entry to convention events or asked to leave the convention space until they can return with a valid membership badge. Furry Connection North reserves the right to refuse membership to anyone based on our own discretion.

“Minors” are defined as any individual 17 years of age or under. Minors aged 16 or 17 may attend FCN events unsupervised by a legal guardian under the condition they can present a 7

signed and notarized statement from the guardian allowing them permission to attend. Furry Connection North cannot be held accountable for minors who gain membership through forgery or other disingenuous methods.

Minors aged 15 years and younger can obtain membership to FCN events only if accompanied personally by a legal guardian throughout the event. Joint memberships are available for parents and their children. While we do endeavor to maintain an atmosphere that is enjoyable for adults and children alike and welcome family attendees, the responsibility of child supervision should not be expected from the FCN staff, security team or other members of the convention. Should the circumstance arise in which an individual with a joint membership must, through administrative action, have their convention privileges revoked, all parties within the joint membership will fall under the same action.

Anyone discovered to have forged a membership card or to be using another member's card under false pretenses will be asked to leave the event and could possibly be referred to local police under a complaint of trespassing. In addition, any member
8 discovered allowing others to "borrow" their membership

card will have their membership immediately revoked and will be asked to leave the event.



THE CONVENTION AREA

The “convention area” is defined as the entirety of the Detroit Novi Sheraton, with the exception of the guest rooms. The standards of conduct should not only be adhered to within the convention space but also in areas viewable from the convention space.

CONVENTION RATING

All public areas within the convention space are to be considered to have a “PG-13” rating. Any convention event containing materials of an adult nature will be noted in the convention book listings and attendance of the event will be monitored by the security 9

staff. Attendance to adult events will be limited to convention members aged 18 years or older.

When in the convention area, hotel lobby or restaurants, shirts, footwear and pants or shorts must be worn unless the attendee is utilizing the pool/spa area. At no time should any attendee wear clothing that is overly revealing, or for blatant sexual or fetish purposes in the convention area. Any attendee discovered wearing clothing that is inappropriate or disruptive to the atmosphere of the convention may be asked to return to their room to re-attire themselves or may lose convention privileges.

“Fursuits” are considered acceptable attire, providing that the design thereof falls within a “PG-13” rating. Any costume design that cannot be considered acceptable to a general audience and cannot be made publicly appropriate with clothing must not be worn in the convention area. While we encourage the presence of costumers, Michigan state law prohibits the sale of alcohol to anyone who cannot be identified.

Public displays of affection must be limited to friendly contact. Overly sexual public behavior will not be allowed.

PERSONAL CONDUCT

While within the convention area, all members will be expected to conduct themselves in a mature fashion. Revocation of membership may be incurred for any individual(s) who, by their actions, become disruptive to the atmosphere of the convention or its members.

Fighting, rough-housing, vandalism of the hotel, yelling, excessive noise, and using excessive vulgarities will be considered disorderly conduct.

No objects may be thrown while in the convention area. Likewise, toys which shoot projectiles (including silly string) will not be allowed.

Sleeping in the convention area will not be allowed.

Please dispose of waste in the proper receptacles.

HARASSMENT

Furry Connection North takes harassment very seriously, be it from other members or from individuals not associated with the convention. If you feel you are being harassed, please tell a member of the staff.

TERMS OF SERVICE

Threats, stalking, deliberate intimidation, demeaning insults or unwelcome physical contact all constitute as harassment. Remember: No means no and stop means stop. If you are told to stop in response to any contact with another individual, you are to immediately end your contact with that person.

Every report of harassment made to the FCN staff will be investigated and dealt with on an individual basis.

WEAPONS

No weapons will be allowed at Furry Connection North. This includes firearms, bladed weapons of any kind, flailing weapons, explosive devices or any object designed to inflict harm. Any individual who is discovered carrying a weapon in the convention area will be ejected from the convention and referred to local authorities. This is the policy of Furry Connection North and supersedes any legally issued weapons carry permit.

Weapon replicas may only be carried if they are part of a performance at the convention and have been presented to and approved by the security staff.

SMOKING

The Detroit Novi Sheraton is a non-smoking hotel. Smoking is permitted outside. If you are a smoker, please be respectful of our non-smoking guests and maintain a distance of at least 50 feet from any hotel entrance when smoking outside.

ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES

The sale, purchase or use of any controlled substance is absolutely forbidden at Furry Connection North. Any individual discovered selling, buying or using illegal drugs in any part of the hotel or surrounding area will immediately have their membership revoked and will be reported to drug enforcement authorities without exception.

ALCOHOL

Furry Connection North asks that while at the convention, alcohol should be used responsibly and in moderation. Alcohol beverages can be found for sale in the bar area of the atrium and in the restaurants. They will also be available for our sponsors in the sponsor lounge without charge. Additional rules may apply for alcohol in the Sponsor's Lounge and will be posted.

No open containers of alcohol will be allowed in the **13**

convention area, with the exception of the sponsor lounge. In the case of the bar within the convention area, no beverages containing alcohol may be carried away from the immediate bar area.

Drink responsibly. Any individual who is discovered being disruptive or belligerent due to inebriation may be escorted to their hotel room. Repeat offenders could have their membership revoked.

The legal drinking age in the state of Michigan is 21 years old. It is a felony in this state to supply anyone under this age with alcohol. If an individual has been found supplying minors with alcohol, their membership will immediately be revoked and they will be reported to the local police. Likewise, any minor who is found drinking or can be reasonably suspected of being intoxicated will lose their membership and be turned into police custody.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

We recommend that personal items not be left in convention space unattended. Furry Connection North and its staff are not responsible for any items lost or stolen. Items found by our staff are turned in to Operations where Lost and Found is kept. If an item is believed lost it may be retrieved there, or for up

to two months following the event. Items will not be kept for the next year. Furry Connection North will do its best to facilitate the return of any items returned to the lost and found after the convention at the attendee's expense.

PETS

Other than legal service animals, no pets will be allowed in the convention area. Please refer to hotel policy for information about pets in guest rooms.

MEDIA AND USE OF VIDEO

FCN's attendees get together each year purely to have fun. The organizers understand that large gatherings of furies may seem an unusual sight to many and thus are often targets of the attention of the media. Some reports in the past have been less than accurate or appropriate and have caused many of our attendees to shy away from the media spotlight. The presence of media, thus, detracts from the ability of our attendees to relax and enjoy the convention. We ask that any members of the media who wish to cover our event first contact us and obtain a press kit and that they not arrive unannounced or unescorted. A person attending FCN may not function in a media capacity without the express written consent of Furry Connection North, Inc. **15**

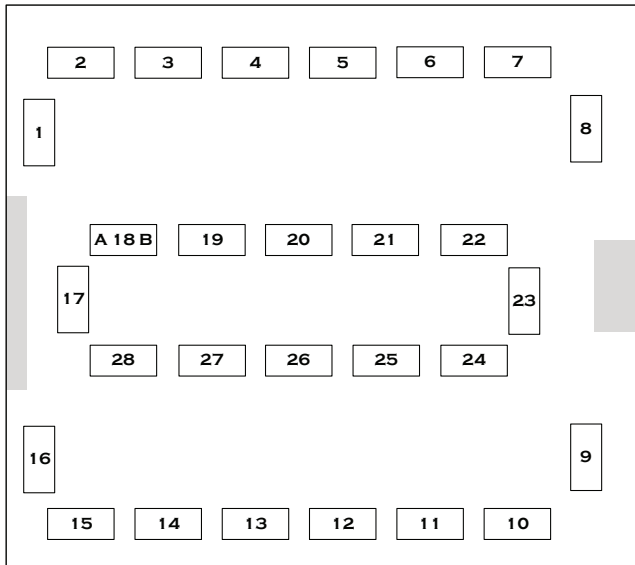

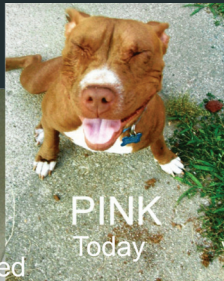

ARTIST'S ALLEY RULES

Artist's Alley will be staffed from 2:00 P.M. until 7:00 P.M. on Friday, 12:00 P.M. until 6:00 P.M. on Saturday, and 10:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. on Sunday. There will be no staff in Artist's Alley after it has closed, therefore transactions are forbidden. The line to wait for Artist's Alley will begin forming one hour prior to opening.

Artist's alley half-table spaces will be assigned at the start of each day by a random lottery. Artists can sign up to have their names included in the lottery starting at 9:30 A.M. on Friday. During the operating hours on Friday and Saturday, artists can sign up to be included in the lottery for the following day, the results of which will be posted outside the Artist's Alley doors after closing each day.

There will be no sales of non-original or pre-made items allowed. These are items that are produced in sizeable quantity before the convention, such as prints, bookmarks, pins, patches, portfolios, calendars, luggage tags, et cetera. These things are restricted for sale in the Dealer's Den only. However, pre-made conbadges and commissions brought for pickup do not apply. Artist's Alley is intended primarily to be for art created and commissioned at Furry Connection North. Furry Connection North is not responsible for your tax obligations in the State of Michigan.

ARTIST'S ALLEY RULES

There will be power available but not enough to accommodate artists at all tables. Because of this, there will be allowances if an Artist needs to visit their hotel room to do any laminating or to drop off or retrieve their computer. This limit shall be no more than 15 minutes per artist, and will be recorded. Please try to not take more than one 'break' every two hours. If you plan to be gone longer than that, you must pack up your things. If you are gone for more than the allotted time, you will forfeit your table space. This is in order to allow fair rotation for artists who had not been yet offered a spot. While you are away, you must designate someone to watch your things. This will not be the responsibility of Furry Connection North. Furry Connection North will not be held liable for unattended items, nor will it be held liable for lost or stolen items. When you leave, even for a break, you must check out with the Artist's Alley Director.

There will be no attaching backdrops, posters, banners or anything of the sort to the walls behind the tables. If you would like to display your name, please do so either by a small frame or stand on your table (though it is not to be higher than one foot off of your table), or tape a small sign to the front of your half of the table.

Please refrain from playing music or movies on any portable devices that may create sound through anything other than headphones. Noise from these objects may disturb the other artists at work.

ARTIST'S ALLEY RULES

If you plan on drawing anything above a PG rating, all efforts must be made to keep the images discretely covered as to prevent any underage observer from viewing adult artwork. You must clearly mark any albums you have that are mature, or place a sign on the binder that states mature pieces are contained within.

For easier navigation, there will be a directory board located at the entrance beside the Artist Alley Director's table. This directory will tell people which table (and which half) you are located at. It will be changed upon sign-in and sign-out, so would be current to who is there at that moment.

To obtain a table you must be a registered FCN attendee. When you sign in, you will be required to give your real legal name, your convention badge name, your badge number and a signature. By signing for table space, you will be acknowledging that Furry Connection North is not responsible for your items in any way, shape, or form, and that you agree to abide by the guidelines set above. There will be a copy of these guidelines beside the sign-in form if you would like to go over them again.

Violation of these terms and guidelines could lead to disciplinary action up to removal from Artist's Alley or removal from the convention. You have agreed to abide by the above rules by signing up for and occupying a table.

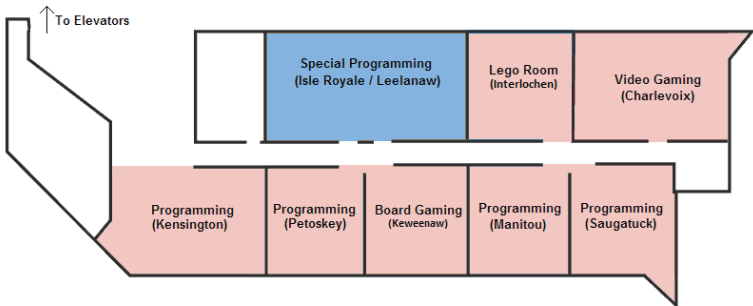

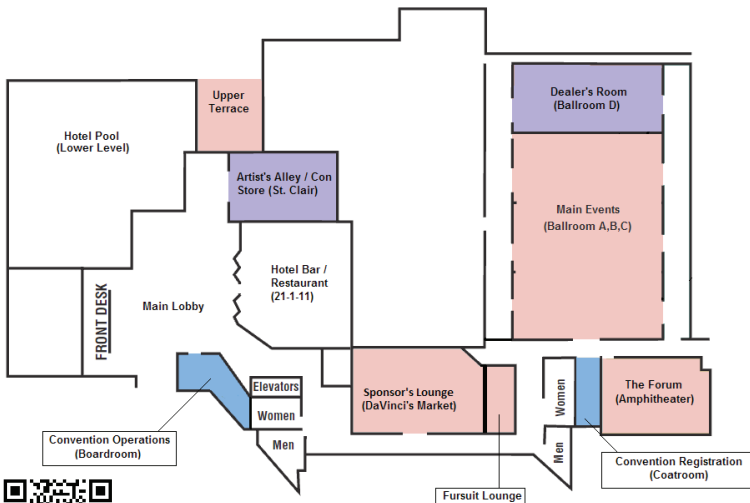
